



Adobe solutions support third-party integration so you can do more from anywhere.

Using Microsoft Office 365?

- **Adobe Acrobat DC and PDF services**—Use PDF services as part of Acrobat DC to convert, combine, or organize pages in a PDF, or export inside of Microsoft OneDrive or Microsoft SharePoint.
- **Adobe Sign**—Use e-signatures, document routing and tracking in Microsoft Word and Microsoft Outlook; add signing steps to SharePoint workflows; create, share, and approve your assets and electronic agreements in Microsoft Teams.
- **PDF document security**—Open PDFs are protected by Microsoft Information Protection solutions, including Azure Information Protection and Office 365; viewing and commenting are supported for all SharePoint and OneDrive users.
- **Adobe Creative Cloud for Teams/Creative Cloud for Word and Microsoft PowerPoint**—Collaborate by sharing files stored in Creative Cloud, get feedback, and stay up-to-date with actions taken on your assets right from Microsoft Teams. Bring your creative elements in Creative Cloud Libraries into Word and PowerPoint directly from Office 365.

Using Slack?

- Share Creative Cloud files in Slack channels, or one-on-one with team members.
- Receive notification and respond directly every time a collaborator leaves a comment in Adobe XD. (*Commenting notifications in Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, and Adobe InDesign coming soon.*)

Using G Suite?

- Easily view, annotate, send for signature, convert, modify, organize pages, and combine multiple file types into a single PDF—all while staying inside Google Drive.
- Share links to your creative assets in Creative Cloud Libraries via email.
- Easily search for Adobe Stock images without leaving your Google Slides presentation.

Using other work management platforms?

- Streamline workflows by bringing tools like Asana, Workfront, Wrike, Jira, GoProof, and PageProof into Creative Cloud apps.

Need virtualization support?

- **Acrobat DC**—You can deploy Acrobat products on virtual machines using VMware Horizon, Citrix XenApp, Citrix XenDesktop, Microsoft App-V, and Windows Terminal Server.
- **Creative Cloud**—Adobe has conducted limited testing of some Creative Cloud products in virtualized or server-based environments, including Citrix Metaframe/Citrix Presentation Server, Microsoft App-V, VMware, Parallels, and Virtual PC.
